
COMPACT AND FOLDABLE

Fold up the stairlift when not in use to save space in corridors or hallways.



REMOTE CONTROL

Two remote controls are included for both upstairs and downstairs so you can send for your stairlift at the touch of a button.



RAIL START AND END

The rail start and ending can be adjusted to your personal preference and situation. A flush finish, for example, is ideal if there isn't a lot of space at the top of the stairs.



COMFORT AND SAFETY

The powered footrest eliminates the need to bend, safely folding or unfolding the footrest for you.

Automatic hinged rail

If there is limited space at the bottom of the stairs or if the rail blocks the hallway or a door, you can choose the automatic hinged rail.

Space

Once installed, there will still be enough free space on the stairs to walk up and down safely.



Seat swivel

Upon arriving at the top of the stairs, you can swivel the seat towards the top landing for a much easier and safer exit. This can be done manually but automatic seat swivelling is available as an option as well. Simply hold the ergonomically designed joystick towards the top landing and the seat will swivel automatically.



Safety stop

The stairlift is fitted with safety sensors that will stop the lift whenever it runs into an obstacle.



Load capacity


The weight limit on the Handicare 2000 is 115 kg / 18 st. The weight limit can be increased to 137 kg / 21½ st with the heavy duty kit.







Smart Perch Seat

If you have a narrow staircase or problems with your knee or hip joints and cannot sit down, the Smart Perch seat is an ideal choice for you. The raised seat and the reduced seat depth allow you to use the lift in a standing position while being secured by a seatbelt.

How to use the stairlift

STEP 1

Fold down the armrest, the seat and the footrest and sit down on the stairlift. The optional powered footrest enables you to unfold the footrest automatically.



STEP 2

Fasten the seatbelt. Your stairlift is fitted with a retractable seat belt as standard. Alternatively, the stairlift can be fitted with a Velcro seat belt.




STEP 3

When you're comfortable and secure, use the ergonomically designed toggle to operate the stairlift.




STEP 4

Hold the toggle until the stairlift arrives at the top landing where it will stop automatically.



STEP 5

Once upstairs, you can use the swivel handles or automatic swivel function to swivel the seat towards the top landing. This guarantees you an easy and safe exit from the stairlift.



WHAT IS A STAIRLIFT?

A stairlift consists of a rail, a chassis with power unit and a seat. The seat is mounted on the chassis. While in use the stairlift moves the seat up and down along the rail.

CAN A STAIRLIFT BE INSTALLED ON MY STAIRCASE?

Handicare offers a wide selection of stairlifts for straight and curved stairs. With a variety of lift models we are able to provide a suitable solution for each setting regardless of whether the stairs are narrow, steep, curved or long. Handicare always has a fitting solution for your staircase.

IS IT IMPORTANT TO DETERMINE ON WHICH SIDE OF THE STAIRCASE THE STAIRLIFT IS INSTALLED?
